CITY OF DUBUQUE BOARD AND COMMISSION OPPORTUNITIES

The City of Dubuque is currently seeking volunteers to serve on the City of Dubuque Building Code and Advisory Appeals Board. The board meets as needed and their primary responsibilities are to determine the suitability of alternative building materials and methods of building construction, provide for reasonable interpretation of the provisions of the international building code, advise the city council on all building construction regulations and procedures, and serve as an appeal body for the decisions of the city building official. The board is comprised of seven (7) residents of the city, appointed by the city council. Membership includes an architect or engineer registered in the state of Iowa, a commercial contractor, a journeyman carpenter, a residential contractor, a representative of the public at large, and two (2) representatives with knowledge of Americans With Disabilities Act regulations. All board members must reside in the City of Dubuque and serve voluntarily without compensation.

Boards and commissions play an important role in governing the City of Dubuque. These advisory groups are valuable community partners with the City Council and City staff and help in guiding the future of the community. The Building Code and Advisory Appeals Board serves a vital link between City of Dubuque government and the residents and building professionals in our community. The City of Dubuque currently has 3 vacancies on the Building Code and Advisory Appeals Board. tiny house project

High school students from the Alternative Learning Center have been very busy putting together a plan to build a tiny house. The purpose of this project is to familiarize students with the process of building a home from start to finish. The plans are already drawn and approved and the building will start with the fall semester.

Members of the Homebuilders Board of Directors met with the staff and teacher at the Alternative Learning Center to see how the Homebuilders & Associates could get involved. Joe Bormann, the teacher responsible for this project, provided a calendar that they would like to use throughout the semester. Basically his goal is to partner with our organization and provide his students hands on professional experience building this tiny house.

Joe Schmittt, from *Cedar Ridge Construction*, has graciously volunteered to invite these students to his current project in the South Pointe sub-division. Students will be able to witness what it takes to frame a home, the proper way. Thank you Joe for heloing with this tour! Additional tours will be welcome throughout the course of this project.

Joel Mozena, from *Mozena Construction*, has agreed to help on September 5th, teaching the students about the tools used during a typical framing project and the proper use of each tool. Mark Ernst, from *Black Hills Energy* and Lisa Wittman, from *Fidelity Bank* have also agreed to participate in one of the Thursday, A Day of Learning dates.

What does this mean for you? We need your help. We need volunteers who can give 2 hours at a time to teach these students about what you do and the proper way to perform the task.
